Directions to Bellarmine:

From Northern KY/Cincinnati:

Follow I-71 South to I-264 West (Watterson Expressway). Stay on I-264 to the Newburg Road North Exit 15A. Follow Newburg Road 1.5 miles to Bellarmine.

From the east (Frankfort, Lexington, Richmond):

Follow I-64 West to I-264 West (Watterson Expressway). Stay on I-264 to the Newburg Road North Exit 15A. Follow Newburg Road 1.5 miles to Bellarmine.

From the South (Bowling Green, Nashville):

Follow I-65 North to I-264 East (Watterson Expressway). Stay on I-264 to the Newburg Road Exit 15. Turn left and follow Newburg Road 1.5 miles to Bellarmine.

From I-65 South (Indiana):

Follow I-65 South across the Kennedy Bridge to I-264 East (Watterson Expressway). Stay on I-264 to the Newburg Road Exit 15. Turn left and follow Newburg Road 1.5 miles to Bellarmine.

From I-64 East (Western KY/Indiana):

Follow I-64 East to I-65 South. Follow I-65 South to I-264 East (Watterson Expressway). Stay on I-264 to the Newburg Road Exit 15. Turn left and follow Newburg Road 1.5 miles to Bellarmine.

Parking:

There should be plenty of parking on campus. If this is full, free parking is available on adjacent streets.
