DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

Below is a map of the EKU campus, with the Combs building highlighted. There are also directions listed. Several events would be taking place on campus for that Saturday (April 17). Driving to Eastern Kentucky University, Richmond, KY.

1. From I-75 Northbound, take Exit 87 (876/eastern Bypass/Barnes Mill Rd.) Turn right on Eastern Bypass.
2. From I-75 Southbound, take Exit 87 (876/eastern Bypass/Barnes Mill Rd. Turn left on Eastern Bypass.
3. Travel approximately 1.2 miles on Eastern Bypass.
4. Turn left onto Lancaster Ave.
5. Turn right (2nd right) on Park Dr.
6. Take the first left (a sharp left) into the Martin parking lot.
7. Go to Combs Building room 216.
